This issue, we would like to highlight a man who has given years of service to the Baptist Medical Centre: Tommy Harrison.

Tommy grew up in Columbus, Georgia and worked as a mechanic in nearby Phenix City, Alabama.

In the late 1980s, he and his wife started volunteering at BMC. Sadly, his wife died about 10 years ago from cancer. Soon thereafter, Tommy began living near the

hospital and working full time in the Maintenance Department. He learned the Mampruli language and began a village ministry which now occupies much of his time in addition to farming in Nalerigu and his ongoing work at the hospital. Also, Tommy is a driving force in starting a new seminary in the city of Tamale in Northern Ghana.
