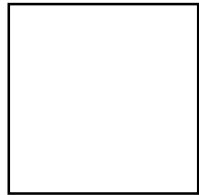
The Friesens were appointed in 1987, but due to problems getting a visa at that time, they did not get to Nalerigu until 1989.
