Growing Interest to Serve at BMC

There has been a growing interest among medical students, residents, and nursing students to serve at BMC. These young medical professionals are able to experience the culture, medical work, and service to God's people in a developing country. The Foundation would like to thank INMED (www.inmed.us), an organization dedicated to preparing medical personnel for mission service, for providing a catalyst and inspiration for many of these students. They have referred several students to us. Studies have shown that 65 to 80% of students with a mission experience during training return part time or full time to serve in the developing world.

With this in mind, the Foundation has agreed to provide financial support for up to 10 students a year totalling \$10,000. We pray these students serve well at BMC and go on to have a lifetime of service to God.
